In case of false/wrong declaration or fabricated documents have been used for procuring permissions of MARB and any misconduct is brought to the notice of National Medical Commission (NMC) or found during surprise assessment at any stage during the current academic year, your institution is liable, not to be considered for recognition of that degree. This letter of permission will be revoked for the current academic year if such exigency arises.

It is mandatory to develop a website of medical college/institution and display all the information of college, courses offered faculty available and their experience of last 5 years, students joined, and affiliating university .to display the hospital services, facilities available and the equipment's in each specialty, also showing OP and IP census including births and deaths as per the municipal/Government records.
